MARCH 16, 2021 – WORK SESSION MEETING MINUTES

OPENING REMARKS: Mayor Emily Haddix, welcomed Council and community to the City of Pleasant Valley Work Session Meeting.

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL: At 6:05 p.m., Mayor Haddix called the meeting to order. Council present - Ed Aberegg; Emily Haddix; Erin Henderson; Chuck Ledsome; Chip Phillips; Gary Timms; and Mike Walls. City Attorney, John Funkhouser, City Clerk, Sherry Roof and Accounting firm, was also present. Absent: Code Enforcement Officer, John Miller. Community Attendance: None.

FINAL BUDGET DISCUSSION W/ACCOUNTANT: Mayor Allen Farcin and Council reviewed the draft budget line for line with Council asking questions for clarification on some items, to which Mr. Farcin made some suggestions for adjustments. Mr. Farcin assured Council and the Mayor that his firm was aware of the process and impending upcoming deadlines and assured Council that everything was on track and on schedule.

DRAINAGE AND ROAD WORK UPDATES: Council Ed Aberegg reported repairs to Nicki Street as complete. Council Chuck Ledsome reported repairs to Serene Drive also complete. Council Mike Walls reported working on a sewer pipe issue in the Brick Hill area of Millersville. Council Chip Phillips reported working with the State on paving for various main as well as side roads. Mayor Haddix reported that she is working to contract with Superior Landscaping to do a spring clean-up of winter road debris. Council Chuck Ledsome reported additional streetlights needing repairs.

BUSINESS UPDATES (PRIORITY ITEM: COMPUTERS, TECHNOLOGY ENHANCEMENTS): The proposal for City Hall computer upgrade and expansion initiative has been signed. MCM business service got the contract. The new Administrative Assistant hire, Carol Christ, would be starting on Monday, April 5.
