



CITY OF PLEASANT VALLEY - ORDINANCE #39

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING USE OF CAMPERS, MOTOR HOMES AND SIMILAR VEHICLES FOR HABITATION, LIVING, AND SLEEPING EXCEPT IN DESIGNATED CAMPING AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLE PARKS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLEASANT VALLEY:

SECTION ONE. No motor home, campervan, truck camper, pop-up camper, travel trailer, teardrop trailer, hybrid trailer, fifth wheel trailer, or recreational vehicle of any kind located on any property within the City of Pleasant Valley shall be used by any person for living, sleeping, housekeeping, or otherwise used for habitation unless such vehicle is located in an area designated by the city as a camping and recreational vehicle park, or is otherwise specifically allowed by an Ordinance of the City of Pleasant Valley.

SECTION TWO. No property owner shall allow the above activities on any property owned by such property owner in the City of Pleasant Valley, except for temporary visitors use for a period not exceeding ten (10) days.

SECTION THREE. Violation of this ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, a personal shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for any offense thereof. Violation of this Ordinance on subsequent days shall constitute additional violations.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
